

# **Two Kinds of Wisdom**

#### James 3:13-18

Key question: What kind of wisdom are you living by?

### 1. The Test of Wisdom (13)

"Who is wise and understanding among you? Let them show it by their good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom."

- Wisdom is not just intellectual; it's shown in behavior.
- A "good life" and humble actions are evidence of true wisdom.
- True wisdom leads to humility, not pride or self-promotion.

## 2. Earthly (False) Wisdom (14-16)

"But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition... such 'wisdom' does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic..."

- Characteristics of False Wisdom:
  - Bitter envy
  - Selfish ambition
  - Leads to disorder and every evil practice
- Sources: Earthly, unspiritual, demonic
- Fruit: Division, chaos, and sin

#### 3. Heavenly (True) Wisdom (17-18)

"But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate..."

- Characteristics of True Wisdom:
  - 1. Pure morally clean, undivided
  - 2. **Peace-loving** seeks harmony
  - 3. Considerate gentle, thoughtful
  - 4. **Submissive** open to reason, humble
  - 5. Full of mercy and good fruit compassionate actions
  - 6. **Impartial** fair, just
  - 7. **Sincere** without hypocrisy
- Fruit of True Wisdom (v. 18):
  - Righteousness is sown in peace by peacemakers.
  - True wisdom builds up others and communities.
