Explore – Discuss how the following verses reflect a mission statement for the life of Jesus and Paul and how those mission statements are manifested in their lives.

The Life of Jesus:

- Luke 19:10 (how does this verse define the life of Jesus as described the story from Luke 19:1-10?)
- Mark 10:45 (how does this verse define the life of Jesus as described the story from Mark 10:35-45?)

The Life of Paul:

- Acts 9:15; Acts 22:21; Romans 11:13
- 2 Corinthians 5:19-20
- Romans 1:1; Philippians 1:1

Not all of us will live with that degree of clarity or purpose in life, but developing a personal mission statement is important. Though God orchestrates our circumstances and directs our paths, far too many Christians live passively, knowing what they were saved *from* without knowing what they were saved *for!*

Prayerful assessment of life, location, career, relationships, habits, and all other relevant components of a calling will help you fulfill your God-given mission.
